Dear Parents

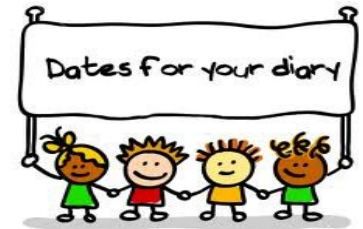
