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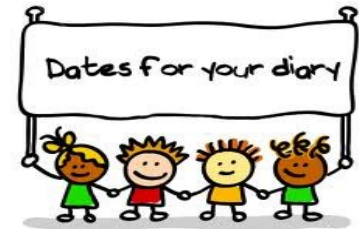
Success at New City Primary School

We have had a successful half term with our Harvest Festival. Children have continued to work hard during this term and their report cards will let you know how well they have been doing.

Our results for the last academic year will be published publicly at the end of this term. Our Key Stage 2 data has shown that we will be the most improved school in Newham with 81% of our children achieving the age related expectations at the end of year 6. This is an improvement of 53% from 2016. The year 6 children have now started their secondary school education. They will have the relevant literacy and numeracy skills to access the secondary curriculum as well as the qualities including resilience and independent learning.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the staff and the parents for their on-going hard work and support. We will continue to have high expectations for all our children to ensure they have the best opportunities for their lives.
