Oh, and she hears a voice coming from the stones of Stonehenge. Meanwhile, Aster is super-bright, and he's travelled the world with his mum, but every time he worries or panics (which is pretty often), his hands start to dissolve into stars. When Vesper accidentally releases some nasty gods from their prison, it's down to her and Aster to help save the world. Kizin, the Maya god of death, is intent on sacrificing every human – unless the cousins beat his team at Pok-a-Tok, the Maya game that's a bit like football. But you can't use your feet.
