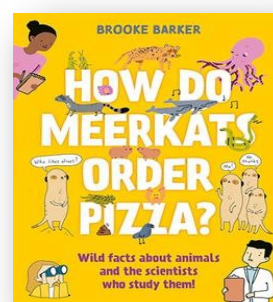

At New City, our Digital Leaders spoke in assembly about Safer Internet Day and why it is important. In our Computing lessons, we had discussions about how to navigate the Internet safely and then designed Online Safety posters.
