






Mr Freeland's Book Review Find Your Happy

When he's feeling blue and things aren't going quite right, he finds his mummy for a big snuggly hug to cheer him up. With the help of his friends, this adorable sloth shows us the techniques he has learned to find his happy while navigating a spectrum of feelings throughout his everyday life. Finding your happy isn't always as straightforward as it sounds, especially for little

ones. This vibrant picture book, featuring cute animals and doodle-like illustrations, is a great introduction to feelings - identifying them and learning how to tackle them.
